This award was created to commemorate Professor Hearn's deep involvement in Semester at Sea and his constant support of study abroad as means to expand the intellectual horizons of undergraduates.

Architectural Studies majors who have applied *or intend to apply* to a study abroad program that is recognized by the University of Pittsburgh for the summer of 2019 or next academic year (2019– 2020) are invited to submit applications.

Students must complete an application form, their resume, and a formal statement (500 – 800 words) explaining where they have applied to study abroad and what they hope to accomplish in that particular program.

- How does your prior course work and academic training, and extracurricular and work experience enable you to succeed in this program?
- How will study abroad further your career plans or other learning objectives?
- Why did you select this particular location and program?
- What are the particular strengths of the program to which you are applying?

The application, statement, and an up-to-date *résumé* (which should list all work and academic experience, honors and awards received, and extracurricular activities) should be submitted as a single .doc or .pdf file to Alyssa DiFolco | ard117@pitt.edu | by 4:00 pm on Friday, April 12, 2019.

The final decision is dependent on the student's acceptance to a study abroad program.
