The History of Art and Architecture department is currently seeking submissions for the annual Friends of the Frick Fine Arts Writing Award that recognizes outstanding achievement in writing in the discipline. You DO NOT need to be a senior to submit a paper for consideration!

Papers can be submitted for consideration in the following categories: Critical and Analytical Writing, Research Writing within an HAA Course, and Independent Research Projects.

Papers produced in this academic year are eligible. Papers previously submitted for this competition should not be resubmitted. Students can only submit one paper per year.

A monetary prize will be given for the best paper in each category. The papers will be judged by the Friends of the Frick Fine Arts Writing Award Committee made up of HAA faculty.

#### **Submission Guidelines:**

- Contestants must be matriculated students in the Dietrich School of Arts and Sciences.
- All submissions must be accompanied by the "Nomination Form," signed by the individual faculty member for whom you produced the original paper. (See below.)
- Each paper must be submitted with two cover pages:
  - The first one lists your name, the title of the paper, the course in which the paper was produced, and the instructor's name.
  - The second cover page lists only the title of the paper.
